  - 10% discount on various services in practice





## Insurance Queries

We often get asked questions on what to look for when taking out insurance for your pet. Taking out an Insurance policy can be confusing and a lot of deals are not as good as they first appear.

We would always advise each pet to be covered by insurance. When taking out an insurance policy you need to look for a **LIFE TIME** policy that will cover your animal for life. This policy renews each year with the amount per condition, per year reinstated.



We would advise against a policy that is for 12 months or time limited. This would mean any condition that your pet develops within that 12 months will no longer be covered the year after and will not be covered by any other insurance company as it will be classed as a pre-existing condition.

Here at Trafford Vets we highly recommend PetPlan as one of the original pet insurance companies. There are plenty of companies out there but please do not hesitate to ask for advice from our members of staff.
